Vendors are reminded that any actual or prospective bidder who is aggrieved by the pending award of the contract or any aspect of the procurement process leading to the award of the contract may protest in writing. A written Notice of Intent to Protest must be filed with ECRC within three (3) business days after the posting of the Notice of Intent to Award. Within ten (10) business days of the Notice of Intent to Protest, the bidder must file a formal written protest. The formal protest must state the name and address of the protester and include a factual summary of the protest, as well as the legal and factual grounds upon which the protest is based. Failure to timely file either the Notice of Intent to Protest or the formal written protest shall result in forfeiture of the right to protest. Filing shall be deemed complete upon receipt by ECRC.
