TRANSPORTATION REGIONAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM (TRIP)

What is it?

The Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP) was created as part of major Growth Management legislation enacted during 2005 Legislative Session (SB 360). The purpose of this program is to encourage regional planning by providing state matching funds for improvements to regionally significant transportation facilities identified and prioritized by regional partners.

Who is eligible to participate?

- Two or more contiguous MPOs
- One or more MPOs and one or more contiguous counties that are not members of a MPO
- A multi-county regional transportation authority created by or pursuant to law
- Two or more contiguous counties that are not members of a MPO
- MPOs comprised of three or more counties

What is it?

The Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TA) was established by Congress to help fund a variety of small-scale transportation projects such as:

- Pedestrian and bicycle facilities
- Recreational trails,
- Community improvements such as historic preservation and vegetation management, and
- Environmental mitigation related to stormwater and habitat connectivity.

Who is eligible to participate?

- Local Governments,
- · Regional transportation authorities,
- Transit agencies,
- · Non-profit entities, and
- Others
